

TEACHING CHILDREN EXCELLENCE



Q What does NDI New Mexico do?

A NDI New Mexico teaches children excellence through the dynamic discipline of dance. We are one of the largest organizations serving youth in our state and our programs address critical youth development needs. We offer three complementary programs - In-School, After-School and Advanced Training.

Q How does NDI New Mexico work with the public schools on the In-School Program?

A NDI New Mexico partners with public schools in Albuquerque, Santa Fe, and Northern New Mexico communities such as Española and Chimayó, to offer the In-School Program for 3rd to 5th graders. For a full 15 weeks (a semester) or 30 weeks (the full school year) entire classes participate – no child left behind!

A certified NDI New MExico instructor and a pianist lead these classes and prepare students to perform in the big Year-End Event that crowns their NDI-NM experience. At each performance, more than 500 students from different schools collaborate as a dance troupe and learn a new level of teamwork.

Through the NDI New Mexico Residency Program, an abbreviated version of the In-School Program is offered to an additional 23 communities.

For these services, the schools pay a nominal fee. It is approximately 20 percent of actual program costs, plus a sliding-scale amount based on the number of children who receive free or reduced-cost meals.

There are over 90 schools on the waiting list for NDI-NM classes. Our ability to meet this demand is limited by the number of qualified instructors and funding available.

Q What is the Advanced Training Program?

A NDI-NM instructors and their partnering classroom teachers recommend their highly motivated students to audition for the Advanced Training Program. If accepted, they take in-depth classes after-school and on weekends, with the opportunity for progressive training from year to year. Participation is generally without charge, although classes for XCel students and the Summer Institute are offered on a sliding scale.

The Advanced Training groups are SWAT (Super Wonderful Advanced Team) for elementary school students, Celebration for middle schoolers, and Company Xcel for high school-age students.

Q What happens after school at The Dance Barns and The Hiland?

A At both The Dance Barns and The Hiland, NDI New Mexico welcomes beginning, intermediate and advanced students ages 3 to 18. Some adult classes are also offered. Classes include ballet, tap, hip-hop, theater, voice, and more. Tuition is arranged on a sliding scale so all interested students have access to classes.

SPOTLIGHT ON KEGAN MALEC-BARRERA

Kegan Malec-Barrera was 9 years old when he started dancing with NDI New Mexico at Carlos Gilbert Elementary in Santa Fe. He has pursued the continuum of training at NDI New Mexico from that initial in-school class to SWAT, then Celebration, and finally Company XCel. This year, at age 18, he is the only senior in Company XCel. After graduation from from the Academy of Technology and the Classics, Kegan will attend Oklahoma City University and major in musical theatre.

Last fall, during a tap demonstration for the Board of Directors, Kegan was asked the question, "What does NDI New Mexico do?" Without hesitation, he responded, "NDI New Mexico makes children better."

Reflecting on his years with NDI-NM, Kegan adds, "NDI New Mexico has given me a place where I can grow within my art. I have people to inspire me even if the path gets tough. Thank you to everyone who had me as a student thoughout my time at NDI New Mexico. I hope to give back someday by teaching and continuing to take classes when I am on break from college."

His encourages other NDI-NM students, especially his friends on Company XCel, to stick with it. You never know where it will take you! ■



When and how was NDI New Mexico founded?

A During her professional career. Catherine Oppenheimer danced with New York City Ballet and Twyla Tharp's company. But her biggest leap of all came when she started NDI New Mexico out of her living room in 1994! She co-founded NDI New Mexico with Jacques d'Amboise, her mentor, who started teaching residencies in New Mexico in 1990. An athletic American dancer and former principal with New York City Ballet, Jacques chose to offer classes in New York City schools and developed a highly effective kinesthetic teaching methodology. In 1976 he created an organization, National Dance Institute, to support this work.

Catherine incorporated NDI New Mexico as a non-profit charitable organization in 1995, evolved its pedagogy, and soon adapted the urban model of National Dance Institute into a program structure ideal for New Mexico's rural reality. As NDI New Mexico grew, she became a mentor in her own right.

Q What does the "national" in National Dance **Institute New Mexico mean?**

A Although Jacques d'Amboise named his organization National Dance Institute, there is no national umbrella organization. NDI New Mexico is an independent non-profit charitable organization. Today, a total of 12 loosely affiliated organizations across the country offer classes using the NDI methodology. NDI New Mexico is noted for our annual Teaching Excellence® Teacher Training workshop that attracts dancers from across the country.

Q Why are The Dance Barns called The Dance Barns?

A Because they're barns - four pre-fabricated ones, joined together by corridors and doors. This approach made construction both speedy and economical. It's amazing what a good architect and a coat of stucco can do! Thousands of visitors annually admire the warm, welcoming atmosphere and professional quality of our complex. The property is on a long-term lease from Santa Fe Public Schools.

Q What's some history on the renovation of The Hiland?

A Since it opened April 20, 1950, this historic movie theater has been a landmark on Route 66. Generations of couples fondly remember smoothing in the balcony! In a public-private partnership, Bernalillo County owns the building and maintains the shell while NDI New Mexico holds a 60-year lease and has transformed the interior. We refurbished the original, highly recognizable marquee and integrated the Walgreen's next door to become our first-phase dance studi



Young faces wear smiles and earnest concentration when an NDI New Mexico instructor calls out, "First I go and then you go!"

And off they go, full of the dynamic discipline that fuels NDI New Mexico. Crisp stretching fingers, stomping feet, the wiggle move, runs and jumps, the enthusiasm of the instructor and pianist – all this energizes the students.

During a year of classes, students build mental and physical stamina, develop coordination and teamwork, and master choreography. They also absorb the character-building lessons expressed in NDI-NM's Core 4: Work hard, do your best, never give up, be fit!

Dynamic discipline is also required for offstage success. In 2011, NDI New Mexico received a grant from the Kresge Foundation to develop a strategic business plan, including a plan to fund facility maintenance. Fulfilling the grant was the administrative equivalent of runs and jumps!

Thanks to the Kresge grant, NDI New Mexico retained TDC, a Boston-based management and consulting firm. They interviewed board and staff, undertook an intensive review of internal documents, and facilitated a committee of board and staff members to develop the plan. We took a fresh look at who we are and what we do.

After calculating, dissecting and compiling five years of income and expense projections, with related programmatic descriptions, a key outcome of the planning discussion emerged: a recognition that NDI New Mexico is one of the largest youth-serving organizations in our state and our programs address critical youth development needs.

Meeting Critical Youth Development Needs in New Mexico

Quality Counts 2012, a publication of Education Week, ranks New Mexico 50th of all states and the District of Columbia for a child's chance of success. New Mexico's children are alarmingly vulnerable and face significant obstacles: health disparities, rural isolation and poverty, low educational outcomes, and high rates of drug trafficking and crime. The children of New Mexico navigate a high-risk environment as they attempt to achieve a positive future.

NDI New Mexico instills discipline, a standard of excellence, and selfconfidence that set the stage for effective learning both in the classroom and throughout life. The In-School Program is inclusive; all children in a participating classroom dance together, regardless of talent, experience, or special needs. Often, parents who have had little contact with their child's development through school activities eagerly support their participation in NDI New Mexico.

To combat the health disparities in our state, our in-school classes incorporate HIP to Be Fit®, a fitness and nutrition curriculum that NDI New Mexico developed through a federal grant from the Carol M. White Physical Education Program.

The Next Moves for NDI New Mexico

NDI New Mexico understands that quality arts education is a means to achieving positive outcomes for children, such as graduation from high school, maintaining healthy lifestyles, and becoming productive members of their communities. We know that we are part of a larger network of stakeholders working toward the same goals and that we cannot change the lives of New Mexico's children alone. Collaboration and community building are required.

Looking forward, NDI New Mexico will frame its outcomes in three distinct but interrelated ways.

Address the broad goals of youth development, including educational achievement, health and safety, social and emotional development, and self-sufficiency, while expanding reach and depth.

Russell Baker, Executive & Artistic Director

Catherine Oppenheimer, NDI New Mexico's Founding Artistic Director, fondly remembers Russell Baker when he first came to New Mexico for Teaching Excellence® Teacher Training. "I was so impressed with this man," she recalls. "Before he left, I told him that whenever he wanted to come back, I had a job for him. It happened sooner than we expected, in about six months! That was a decade ago." Since then, "It has been so exciting to see Russell grow with the organization, from instructor to Artistic Director, and then to take on the challenge of Executive Director in 2008."

Russell holds a B.A. from Vassar College and an M.F.A. in Ballet Teaching and Choreography from the University of Utah. He danced professionally for 10 years with Kansas City Ballet (KCB) in principal, solo, and character roles. He also taught in the company's Kansas City Ballet School, as well as with KCB's Reach Out and Dance program for children. He founded the Kansas City Contemporary Dance Ensemble and has created and choreographed several ballets.

On any given day at The Dance Barns or The Hiland, Russell might be found in a suit and tie, giving donors a building tour, or in a T-shirt, jeans, and sneakers, teaching Boys Ballet Boot Camp. Or you might find him collaborating on choreography for the year-end event or coaching advanced students.

"What I love most about NDI New Mexico are the people - all the people!" he says with his unfailingly brilliant smile. "Our Board, staff, and instructors. Our families, all the children and parents. I love working with all of them."

"I remember how passionate I was about my dance career, the dedication and commitment it required. I wondered how I could ever replace the feelings of joy and satisfaction that I found as a professional dancer. Then I found NDI New Mexico. I channel all that dedication, commitment and passion into my work every day."

Russell is among the six NDI New Mexico 10-year employees honored by the Board and staff this year. Bravo, Russell! You show us what it means to work hard, do your best, never give up, and be fit! ■

Focusing attention there will allow NDI New Mexico to increase its impact on the children and families of New Mexico.

To build the capacity necessary to serve the need in Albuqueraue. NDI New Mexico has renovated The Hiland, a landmark theater on Route 66 in the southeast quadrant of the city. The Hiland will also serve as a hub for the Residency Program in central and southern New Mexico.

To achieve our vision. NDI New Mexico has set the following goals over the next five years:

- 1. Expand programming, both inschool and out of school, to achieve breadth and depth in meeting youth development needs. At the end of the plan period in five years, NDI New Mexico expects to reach a total of 8,720 children statewide, an increase of 43 percent over the 6.800 children served today.
- 2. Train more high-quality instructors by initiating a nationwide recruiting effort and by offering the Teaching Excellence® Teacher Training Program in both Albuquerque and Santa Fe. We also will identify talented instructors from our growing group of alumni.
- 3. Expand the scope of outcomes in our evaluation measures. To document

NDI New Mexico's expanded scope of impact, evaluation efforts that measure health, academic and life outcomes. and community engagement will be strengthened.

- 4. Develop community partnerships that place NDI New Mexico's work in context of broader youth development and community-building efforts in Albuquerque, our state, and throughout the nation.
- **5.** Focus on using the arts as a means to place-making in Albuquerque by developing and activating The Hiland. NDI New Mexico will work with the City of Albuquerque, real estate developers, schools and other youth-serving organizations, neighborhood business owners, arts organizations, and others to deepen our involvement in the Highland neighborhood.
- 6. Continue to strengthen our financial sustainability.



NDI New Mexico collaborates annually with an independent research firm to gather statistics and stories about the impact of our programs. What we find is that character development is a consistent theme. This is an exciting fact, since education research shows that character development may predict adult success more accurately than grades or test scores.

What They Say

Parents note how NDI New Mexico brings out positive energy in their children and helps them develop teamwork skills.

Advanced Training students and their parents say: NDI New Mexico helps students establish their identities, develop positive behaviors, and form positive relationships

with adults. Students feel that NDI New Mexico allows them to perform to the best of their abilities in an atmosphere of acceptance.

NDI New Mexico collected New Mexico Standards-Based Assessment (NMSBA) test scores for the school years between 2006 and 2010, for 396 public school students who participated in the NDI New Mexico Advanced Training Program. Participating students were in grades 4 through 8. Comparing these results to the other students in their schools, NDI New Mexico students scored consistently higher than their peers, ranging from 10 to 27 points higher.

Participation in NDI New Mexico may have influenced these students' academic performance. Participation requires persistence, strong levels of discipline, the ability to produce a desired result, a willingness to try new things, and knowledge that "doing one's best" matters.

SPOTLIGHT ON ALUMNI PARTY

On December 21, 2011, the halls of The Dance Barns resounded with laughter, music and reminiscing of 50 alumni students and families and 17 current and former NDI New Mexico staff members. I had three goals as I began my first year as Program Director at The Dance Barns.
The first was to achieve the goal NDI New Mexico set several years ago, to enroll at least 500 students in our After-School Program. Well, we doubled our enrollment from last year, and now have more than

from last year, and now have more than 500 students. On some days, we could use another studio!

Second was to expand the depth and breadth of our younger level program, as this is where it all begins. I feel it is very important to continue to refine our programming at every level, so that

The third goal was to elevate the quality of instruction and experience for our most advanced students, the 22 teens in Company XCel – to offer them more challenges in learning technique and choreography. I treat these students as pre-professional, emerging artists who aspire to the highest level of performance. Our *Winter Dance Escape* February 24 through 26, with its very diverse repertoire, pushed the envelope for them.

I invited two guest choreographers – Curtis Uhlemann from Moving People Dance Company, and Campbell Martin, a former Broadway performer – to create pieces for Company XCel.

Curtis created a haunting modern

piece set to music by Lila Downs. Campbell wanted more male dancers, so nine boys from our Celebration Team, ages 12 to 13, auditioned and were added to the cast of "Broad-Ville: From Paris to Paree." The expectations were very high and they all worked hard to meet them. This piece also featured a classic vaudeville dancing cow, and a gorilla in tutu and toe shoes!

I choreographed a piece for the Junior Company, featuring talented dancers ages 9 to 11. "With Our Own Two Hands" is a suite of dances about making a difference in the world, with very upbeat music by George Johnson and Ben Harper.

I worked with the dancers to create steps based on normal everyday activities, what we might call "recycled steps." I also incorporated American Sign Language into the choreography. The refrain to one song is "reduce, reuse, recycle," and we're excited that the City of Santa Fe may use video footage of it to promote their recycling program.

Thanks to a grant from the Thaw Charitable Trust, we've been able to bring guest artists to work with our advanced students. We've had Germaine Salsberg, a master tap teacher from New York; Christine Spizzo, a former dancer with American Ballet Theatre;

and Linda Monich, a distinguished dance historian. And we're always blessed when Jacques d'Amboise visits Santa Fe and takes time to work with our students, as he did in March this year.

Our dancers are encouraged to audition for summer intensive workshops nationwide. Many are attending summer programs at Ballet Chicago, Perry-Mansfield Performing Arts School & Camp in Colorado, Rockettes Summer Intensive in New York, and Complexions Contemporary Ballet in Detroit. It's great to see them leave here with confidence and come back with even more!

Summer 2012 at The Dance Barns

Since 2005, when NDI New Mexico developed its HIP to Be Fit® program with funding from the US Department of Education, we have built powerful partnerships to improve the health and wellbeing of our students. Partnering with the NM Department of Health, United Way of Santa Fe County, Agua Fria, Salazar and Kaune Elementary Schools and La Familia Medical Center, we piloted a HIP to Be Fit® After-School Club in Santa Fe from 2006 – 2010, using NDI New Mexico dance, movement and games to teach children healthy nutrition and good eating habits.
