Outreach students learn about these qualities in each class and years later, alumni reveal that these values stick with them. Executive functioning skills such as; problem solving, planning, and prioritizing, along with collaborative skills and self-efficacy empower our participants to become productive leaders in their communities.

"Candice is a great representative of NDI New Mexico's teaching and lifestyle programs. Her time there translated well into her role at LANB. NDI New Mexico's performances impact thousands of young dancers from schools throughout the outreach programs in Santa Fe, Albuquerque, Northern New Mexico, and in smaller satellite locations around the state. Students come together from different schools, grades, and backgrounds, and are supportive of one another as they reach for a shared goal. Whispered encouragements – "You guys were so great!" and "Good luck! You've got this!" – circulate during rehearsals and performances.

help with choreography, and exchanging compliments with one another – caringly called 'warm-fuzzies'. NDI New Mexico students learn to look for the good in one other – recognize, express and appreciate it – and, receive it from their peers."

Muralist Rebecca Chornenky, worked with students at the 2017 Wallis Annenberg Santa Fe Summer Institute and witnessed NDI's influence in action. "NDI New Mexico embodies a uniquely successful educational culture, and aspects of this are mirrored by the positive and energetic dispositions of the students I worked with at the Summer Institute." Rebecca collaborated with students at the workshop which focused on the theme of heroism, to create a student-driven mural about New Mexico heroes. "They were confident and willing to participate, far more than children I see in other classroom settings. I think it is because these students have already had the experience of being seen and affirmed at NDI New Mexico - and of being met with kindness, care, and joyful guidance."


The combination of joyful learning along with rigorous standards is key to the students' growth experience.
